

2022 has been a great year so far! We have been able to have our full calendar schedule this year, God is good! We are thankful to have been able to have all 10 weeks of our summer camp. We had 2,447 campers this summer, this is still about 600 shy of our 2019 attendance. 149 were saved and 2 surrendered to ministry. Yes, God is so good! Please pray for our churches. For church camps, like Budd Creek, to survive, our churches must have young people to bring.

We continue to work on the dormitory bathrooms. This project began in 2020 and we have just demoed our fourth bathroom. This will give us two new bathrooms for the boys and two for the girls. This process is intense, and we are thankful for those who continue to help with demolition, plumbing, concrete, and financial support.

We have experienced a dry and hot summer. This has put a strain on several of our air conditioning units. The dorm heat and air units were installed around 25 years ago. Two dorm units and one cafeteria unit didn't make it and a couple of others have given us trouble as well. We have someone who has helped us get and install these units at cost. We are very grateful to the camp groups and churches who have made special donations to help with these unexpected expenses.

We want to thank all the churches who continue to support the camp monthly, it helps us keep costs as low as we can. If your church can increase that monthly offering, we thank you for that as well. Also, thank you to those who have sent VBS and other special offerings to help with the projects going on at the camp. Most importantly we thank those who have brought young people to camp this summer, it changes lives!
