We have experienced a very hot end to the summer, which puts a strain on air conditioning units. This spring we were able to replace one dorm unit, one cafeteria unit, and the two kitchen units. We have also had to replace a couple of motors on the one of the Worship Center units. We appreciate all those who have volunteered their time and have given financial support to this project.

We have battled a swimming pool leak for several years now and it has gotten worse this summer. We have located the problem and hope to get it repaired before camps begin in 2024.

We want to thank all the churches who continue to support the camp monthly, it helps us keep costs as low as we can. We also want to thank Arkansas State Mission Project and First Baptist Church in Cave City, for making Budd Creek the second quarter offering recipient! Those funds will definitely help in making repairs and upgrades to our facilities. Also, thank you to those who have sent VBS and other special offerings to help with the projects going on at the camp. Most importantly we thank those who have brought young people to camp this summer, it changes lives!
