Retreat Rules:

1. Your conduct should be such that pleases Christ whom you represent.
2. No boys are allowed in the girl's area.
No girls are allowed in the boy's area.
3. Please leave facilities neat and clean as found when you arrived.
4. Each participant is required to attend and participate in the educational and recreational activities.
5. Modest attire should be worn at all times. EACH SPONSOR is responsible for their participant's dress and conduct.
6. Participants are to follow the instruction of sponsors and camp leaders at all times.
7. No one will be permitted to leave the campground during the weekend except in the event of an emergency, and then only when accompanied by an adult, and the knowledge of the host church.
8. No tobacco or alcohol will be permitted on the grounds.
9. No personal electronic devices should be used during sessions.
10. Inappropriate bodily contact is not allowed.
11. In the event of questions concerning application or interpretation of the rules, the final decision rests with the Camp Director or Host Church.
