



Friends of Budd Creek Camp:

I pray that you, your family, and your church family are all safe despite the turmoil of this world. Times like these remind us that this world is not our home. We are just sojourners preparing for our eternal home with our Lord and Savior – King Jesus. Despite the challenges, we praise Him and thank Him for His goodness to each of us!

I am sad to share with you that we will not be hosting campers at Budd Creek Camp this summer. We have made this decision after much prayer, wise counsel, and consulting with medical professionals within our fellowship. The health and welfare of campers, sponsors, and our camp workers is our major concern.

Due to the challenges of meeting the Arkansas Health Department Guidelines for overnight camps we, the trustees, feel that it is very unlikely we could provide a safe, yet enjoyable camping experience while meeting these requirements. The major hurdle would be the recommendation that anyone attending camp or entering the grounds be completely home quarantined for 14 days prior to camp and have a COVID-19 test within 4 days prior to attending. If this requirement is not met, the camp attendee would have to wear a face covering while at camp. While it might be possible for someone who really wants to attend to meet this requirement and the other guidelines, these restrictions would be hard to adhere to and monitor.

In anticipation of this announcement, several have asked regarding the financial status of the camp, with no revenue coming in from camp fees and concessions. As always, we have faith in God and His people. Many churches and individuals faithfully contribute each month to the camp. We so appreciate your generosity! Without the cash flow from campers' fees, despite the greatly reduced expenses, we do anticipate the need for extra revenue. If you or your church can send an extra offering or even a portion of the funds that you would have spent for campers' fees, that will help tremendously. One of our planned projects is the much needed remodeling of the restrooms in our dorms. Any funds available, in addition to covering our regular expenses, will be used for this project. It will take a lot of money to remodel all of these facilities, so we will do so as the funds become available. Hopefully, with the camp vacant this summer, we can get going on this project.

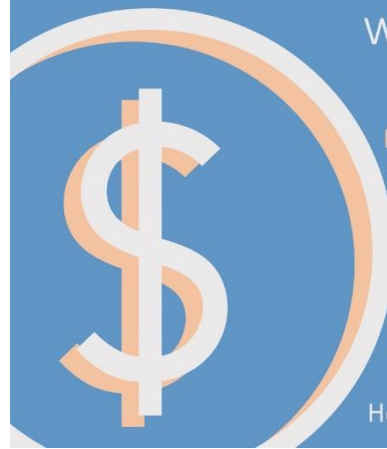
What's Next?
